SIMS Pay

The school has registered with SIMS Pay, a company providing a flexible, online payment facility for school items. Initially the facility will enable parents/carers to check and pay for school dinners. We hope that the rollout is successful and that it will be extended to cover school trips, productions and even wrap around care bookings.

Parents/carers who we hold a current email address for will have received an email this week providing a link to the SIMS Pay registration page and a unique invitation code to enable them to register their SIMS Pay account.

We will continue to accept payment by cash or cheque for the time being.

In KS1, the trophy for the most children reading at least 5 times a week was won by class 3, with 79% of the class reaching the goal of 5 reads recorded in reading diaries.

In KS2 the average reading time per child has continued to increase as good reading habits have become established this year.

Last week the KS2 average reading time per child per day was just above 67 minutes!
