





Summer Clothing

Please make sure that children come to school in suitable clothing and footwear during the summer term.

We advise against children coming to school in tops where children's shoulders are not covered due to the fact that they will be out in the sun during break and lunchtime.

We encourage sun hats to be worn.



Please also make sure that children's shoes are suitable for running, climbing and general play. It is not a good idea for children to wear shoes that do not protect their toes.



Earrings and in School

We have recently reviewed our policy on earrings in light of advice from the local authority.

We have decided to continue to allow earrings to be worn in school as long as they are studs only.

From September, children will not be able to wear earrings for sporting activities.

It is our advice that children should not wear earrings on the day of PE if they cannot take out their own earrings as adults cannot do this for them.



The school cannot take responsibility for earrings that get mislaid during the course of the day.

As many of you will be aware, the world cycling event, 'Le Tour de France', is coming to Cambridge.

There will be road closures in place from the previous evening which will disrupt traffic in the city on the day; in addition, there will be thousands of extra visitors and vehicles (riders, officials, press, spectators) to Cambridge on the day.
