**Year 6 SATs – Reminder letter**

As you are aware, the Year 6 SATs will start next Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> May. The children have worked incredibly hard in their lessons this year and we are very proud of each and every one of them!

We would like to remind also you that we will be running a breakfast club free of charge on the mornings that the SATs assessments are taking place (Monday to Thursday). This breakfast club will provide the children with a snack and a chance to relax and settle before the tests to help them to do their best. The breakfast snack will be served in the children’s classrooms from **8.20am** on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May - Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May.
