- Experiment with leaf rubbings. What patterns do you find?

- Grow your own plants – place them in a dark and light place. Do you notice any differences?
- Research food miles and see if you can calculate how many miles your favourite food has travelled.
- Visit the Botanical Gardens in Cambridge to find out more about plants. You could take a picture or write a diary entry to share with the class.

## **Plants**

You may wish to take the time to complete a project at home this half term. Here are some possible starting points or you may have an even better idea for a project.

Your child can bring completed projects into school at any point during the half term so that they can be shared with the class.

### **Maths**

- Measure the height of different plants and present the data in a bar graph.
- Count how many petals there are on different flowers.
- Measure the growth of a plant every day and record results in a results table.

### **Creative Writing**

- Write the diary of a seed as it grows into a plant.
- Find a plant outside, or imagine your own. Describe what it looks, smells, feels, and even tastes like!
- Write a piece of persuasive writing about your favourite plant/vegetable. Why do you think it's the best?
