**Message from Mrs Rawlins – 14.6.21**

I hope that you have had a good weekend. We are certainly enjoying warmer weather, and the children are loving being out on the school field in their playtimes. Mr Tull has asked me to give a little reminder of the main things to remember on these warm days:

- Sunhats can really help, but please make sure that they are named, as this makes it much easier for us to reunite lost hats with their owners
- Named water bottles need to be in school every day, as we are still not able to use drinking fountains. Bottles can be easily refilled in classrooms whenever needed.
- Sun cream – again, please name any sun cream which is sent into school. Children will be able to apply their own cream, so do go through with them how to apply it.
- Clothing and footwear: please check that shoulders, tummies and tops of legs are covered, and that children can run about in their footwear.

A few things to update you on:

**Class photos:** This Wednesday, 16<sup>th</sup> June, we will be having class photographs taken during the morning.

**Empathy Day:** Last Thursday was Empathy Day. As a whole school, we shared a lovely picturebook called 'The Invisible'. There were lots of discussions in classes about the book afterwards.
