Message from Mrs Rawlins - 14.6.21

I hope that you have had a good weekend. We are certainly enjoying warmer weather, and the children are loving being out on the school field in their playtimes. Mr Tull has asked me to give a little reminder of the main things to remember on these warm days:

- Sunhats can really help, but please make sure that they are named, as this makes it much easier for us to reunite lost hats with their owners

- Sun cream again, please name any sun cream which is sent into school. Children will be able to apply their own cream, so do go through with them how to apply it.
- Clothing and footwear: please check that shoulders, tummies and tops of legs are covered, and that children can run about in their footwear.
