Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 2 Half Termly Curriculum Information Letter – Summer Term 2 2024

Maths

This half term we are learning to describe position and direction, and presenting statistics. We are continuing with learning about time. Please support your child to practise telling the time, using an analogue clock, to the nearest 5 minutes (for example, 10 minutes past 4, or 20 minutes to 6). Please continue to support your child in learning their times tables (2x, 5x and 10x) and particularly in recognising the related division facts (e.g. $4 \times 5 = 20$, therefore $20/5 = 4$). Do encourage your child to use TTRockstars to help them improve their accuracy and speed.

Reading

Thank you for continuing to support your child's reading at home. We are still working hard to win the KS1 reading trophy which is awarded weekly to the class in which the most children have read and recorded at least five times home reads in a week. Reading diaries will continue to be checked on a Friday.

PE

PE is on a Thursday and a Friday. Please continue to send your child to school in PE appropriate clothes on Thursdays. We will be doing a lot of PE outside this term so please ensure your child has appropriate footwear in school, or wears trainers to school on PE days. Just a reminder that children are not permitted to wear earrings for PE and long hair should be tied back on PE days.

Transition into KS2

Whilst enjoying our final half term of Year 2 together, we will begin to prepare the children for their transition into Key Stage 2. The children will be joining Key Stage 2 for one playtime each week towards the end of the term. This will allow them to begin to get to know some of the members of Key Stage 2 staff and familiarise themselves with the playground areas. We will also take the children on a 'tour' of the Key Stage 2 corridor and the opportunity to meet Mrs Dowdall, our Assistant Headteacher in KS2. More information will follow about transition arrangements soon.

General information

- Children will continue to be provided with a piece of fruit every day. Please feel free to send in another piece if you would like.
- Please ensure water bottles are in school daily.
- As the weather gets warmer, please do remember sun hats and sun cream. Bottles of sun cream should be clearly named.
