Reading

This half term, we will be looking at the narrative story of 'The Minpins' by Roald Dahl and 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes.

Please continue reading with your child at home on a daily basis and record a comment in their reading diaries.

Spellings:

Our spellings this half term will be a revision of the learning so far this year.

Maths

Times Tables: Please continue to support your child with their times tables. So far this year, we have learnt about the 3, 4, 6 and 8 times tables. We will spend the last half term consolidating these facts. Using their Education City login, children can play Times Table Rock Stars to help them to learn their times tables. This can be accessed through the school website.

Home Learning Projects:

Please have a look at the Home Learning ideas document at some starter ideas for projects that you could complete at home with your child. Our theme for this half term is 'Real and Imaginary Places' based on our trip to BeWILDerwood. As we are asking that children only bring in essential items to school, please don't send in any home learning projects, but do instead take a photograph and send it via Seesaw or by email to the school office, so that they can be displayed for the class to share and enjoy.

PE:

Until further notice, please send children into school in clothes that they can exercise in without the need to change for PE, as it will give us the flexibility to increase the amount of physical activity we do in school. As the weather can still be quite changeable, we may need to do PE lessons on a different day to our usual plan. Children will need to remove earrings for PE and long hair must be tied back. We believe that children can nearly always take part in a PE lesson in some capacity if they are able to attend school. Our policy is that children will take part in PE lessons unless a doctor's note advises in writing against it.

Please remember to send a water bottle daily and a hat for sunny weather.
