Create a Kenyan landscape (paint, draw or collage).

Science / Research

Find out about your favourite Kenyan animal and write a fact file. Include its habitat!

Draw a map of Africa and identify where Kenya and the equator are.

Research the weather and climate in Kenya.

Creative Writing

Write a story about an African animal of your choice.

Write a poem about Kenya.

Create an information page about Kenya.

Imagine you are on safari and write a postcard!

Write about whether you would like to visit Kenya and why.

Find out about the heights and weights of different African animals.

Find out how long it would take to fly to Kenya.

Create a chart or graph showing temperatures in Kenya, the UK and other countries of the world.
