Creative Writing

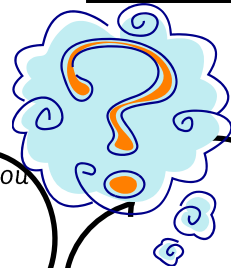
- Write a description of a place that you have explored.
